**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ABANDONMENT OF OBSOLETE
CIVIL DEFENSE SIRENS AND ASSOCIATED POLES/EQUIPMENT**

offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, there are currently three utility poles within the Borough that contain Civil Defense warning sirens that are no longer in use and have been deemed obsolete; and

WHEREAS, the Emergency Management Coordinator and Public Safety Office have determined that sirens at the following locations should be abandoned;

- Maple Avenue and Leroy Place
- River Road and Throckmorton Avenue
- East Bergen Place and Branch Avenue

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Red Bank authorize the Borough Administrator to notify Jersey Central Power and Light (JCP&L) that electrical service to these sirens may be abandoned;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Administrator is authorized to coordinate with JCP&L or any other applicable contractor for the removal of such equipment and poles if they no longer serve a useful purpose.
