**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE REMOVAL OF CERTAIN PROPERTIES FROM THE  
HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION'S LISTING OF PROPERTIES IN NEED OF  
HISTORIC DESIGNATION**

**WHEREAS**, by Red Bank Code Section 2-53.6(a) requires that the Red Bank Historic Preservation Commission provide an annual report to the Mayor and Council along with a listing properties that are in need of recognition of historic designation pursuant to criteria adopted by the Commission and approved by the Mayor and Council; and

**WHEREAS**, Red Bank Code Section 2-53.6(b) requires that the properties set forth on the Historic Preservation Commission's Annual Report be presented to the Governing Body for its approval;

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Red Bank approved the list of properties for inclusion on the Borough's historic registration roster by Resolution No. 17-187 dated August 23, 2017; and

**WHEREAS**, upon being notified of their property's inclusion on the list, some property owners have requested that their property be removed from the Historic Registration Roster.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Red Bank that it does hereby remove the following list of properties from inclusion on the Borough's historic registration roster:

95 East Front Street  
22 Hubbard Park  
11 Vista Place  
96 West Front Street  
98 West Front Street

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Clerk forward a certified true copy of this letter to the Red Bank Historic Preservation Commission, to the Planning Board, to the Board of Adjustment, to the Construction Office and to the owner of each property described above, at the address shown on the Borough's tax records.
