

BEST LIQUORS LICENSE REVOCATION

A decision was handed down today by Administrative Law Judge Joseph F. Martone with respect to the liquor license of Best Liquors. In his 33 page opinion, Hon. Joseph Martone affirmed the actions of the Red Bank Borough Council and affirmed the decision of the Council to revoke the license.

In his decision, Judge Martone explained his recommendation “may be adopted, modified or rejected by the Director of the Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control, who by law is authorized to make a final decision in this matter.”

This will become a final decision if the Director does not adopt, modify, or reject the decision within 45 days.

The decision was based on charges filed against Best Liquors by the Police Department for the sale of alcohol to minors on four different occasions as well as employing an unregistered individual in the summer and fall of 2006.
