**RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT FROM LOCAL GOVERNING BODY
AUTHORIZING THE SUSTAINABLE JERSEY 2022 EDF CLIMATE CORPS
PROGRAM APPLICATION**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Red Bank strives to save tax dollars, assure clean land, air and water, improve working and living environments; and
