EC Goals for 2025:

- Native Plant Ordinance
- Encourage opportunities and alternate ideas to share so that each person contributes
 - Potential idea: Determine spend per household for the borough to remove leaves, which could be used as a grant opportunity.
 - Would it make sense to instead provide a composter to homeowners?
 - Leaves could be a good entry point, less intense than home composting
 - Could we coordinate a Red Bank cleaning day for the Spring?
 - Consider making an educational component for Sustainable Jersey - could encourage involvement with middle school so they can get points
 - Sponsor a storm drain
 - Potential to apply for a grant
 - Sustainable lawns initiatives
