Shade Tree Activities

Maintenance

- ✓ Removed 31 hazardous trees.
- ✓ Mulched trees planted this and last year.
- ✓ Continued the pruning program throughout the borough.
- ✓ Applied for the NJ Forestry Green Communities grant for the 2nd 5-year Community Forestry Management Plan.
- ✓ Applied for the Business Stimulus Fund for tree maintenance.

Planting

- ✓ Continued the tree planting program by adding a total of 55 street and park trees to the Borough forestry.

Inventory

- ✓ Inventoried Zone 4: 308 existing trees, 84 potential planting locations.
- ✓ Added the information to the GIS database.
- ✓ Updated the inventory on the Web using Google Maps.

Community Outreach

- ✓ Held an Arbor Day celebration. Arbor Day Proclamation read at the Council meeting. Tree City USA banner flown over the Borough Hall.
- ✓ Engaged the Green Team from a local church in maintaining new trees at the Primary School.
- ✓ Received Tree City USA designation for the 3rd year.
- ✓ Distributed information at Red Bank Community Day, Riverside Gardens Park events
