### **Shade Tree Activities**

#### **Maintenance**

- ✓ Removed 22 hazardous trees.
- ✓ Mulched and watered trees.
- ✓ Continued the pruning program throughout the borough.
- ✓ Created the second 5-year Community Forestry Management Plan using the NJ Forestry Green Communities grant.
- ✓ Implemented the tree maintenance and removal project using the Business Stimulus Fund award.

#### **Planting**

- ✓ Continued the tree planting program by adding/replacing a total of 20 street trees to the Borough forestry.

#### **Inventory**

- ✓ Inventoried park and street trees: 44 existing/new trees.
- ✓ Added the information to the GIS database.
- ✓ Updated the inventory on the Web using Google Maps.

#### **Community Outreach**

- ✓ Held an Arbor Day celebration with the Red Bank Primary School. Arbor Day Proclamation read at the Council meeting. Tree City USA banner flown over the Borough Hall.
- ✓ Received Tree City USA designation for the 4th year.
- ✓ Distributed information at Farmers Market, Riverside Gardens Park events, Primary School Earth Day
