A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PLACEMENT OF FLAGPOLE AT TIFFANY’S

Mr. DuPont offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, Tiffany and Company is the tenant and landlord of the building where Tiffany is currently engaged in business and has applied for an application to erect two flagpoles on the façade of the building pursuant to previous flagpoles that existed when the building was a United States Post Office; and

WHEREAS, flagpoles may be slightly intrusive in terms of the public right of way air rights over the sidewalk; and

WHEREAS, it is a beneficial addition to the building in question and enhances the streetscape of the Borough of Red Bank;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Red Bank, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey herewith waives any formal application process and permits Tiffany and Company to reinstall the two flagpoles as identified in Exhibit A of the photograph attached.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be transmitted to Tiffany and Company, Red Bank RiverCenter and the Red Bank Director of Planning and Zoning.
