**A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF AN APPLICATION BY RED BANK
AFFORDABLE HOUSING CORPORATION FOR TITLE 39 DESIGNATION**

Mr. Murphy offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, the Red Bank Affordable Housing Corporation is petitioning that Title 39 of the revised Statutes of New Jersey, and other related motor statutes and regulations, be made applicable to the semi-public roads, streets, driveways and parking facilities to be contained within the Cedar Crossing Affordable Housing project; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police of the Borough of Red Bank has recommended the support of the project receiving said designation; and

WHEREAS, the petition has been made a condition of the Corporation's application before the Zoning Board of Adjustment and shall be made to the State of New Jersey Department of Transportation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Red Bank hereby wish to express their support for the petition for Title 39 designation by the Red Bank Affordable Housing Corporation's Cedar Crossing Affordable Housing project and that a copy of this Resolution shall be forwarded to the New Jersey Department of Transportation, DeCotiis, FitzPatrick & Cole, LLP on behalf of the Red Bank Affordable Housing Corporation and the Red Bank Zoning Board of Adjustment.
