**A RESOLUTION REJECTING ALL BIDS FOR A CONTRACT FOR THE PROVISION OF TWO  
31 YARD GARBAGE COLLECTION TRUCKS (CONTRACT NO. 10-1)**

Mr. Murphy offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

**WHEREAS**, on August 31, 2010, two sealed bids were received for two 31 Yard Garbage Collection Trucks (Contract No. 10-1); and

**WHEREAS**, the apparent low bid submitted by Detcon materially deviated from the specifications by promising delivery of the truck within one hundred and thirty days, while the specifications required delivery within ninety days; and

**WHEREAS**, the next lowest bid submitted by Sanitation Equipment Corp. substantially exceeded the Borough's appropriation for these vehicles;

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. §40A:11-13.2 permits a municipality to reject all bids when the lowest bid substantially exceeds its appropriation and cost estimates for the goods and when the municipality determines to substantially revise the specifications for the goods;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Red Bank that all bids for the above mentioned project be rejected; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Borough Administrator is authorized to prepare new specifications and to solicit new bids for this project.
