**CDBG BLOCK GRANT RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR  
TO SIGN A CERTIFICATION PROHIBITING THE USE  
OF EXCESSIVE FORCE AND A CERTIFICATION PROHIBITING  
THE USE OF FEDERAL FUNDS FOR LOBBYING**

Ms. Lee offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

**WHEREAS**, certain federal funds are potentially available to Monmouth County through the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended; and

**WHEREAS**, the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development has allocated funding to the County of Monmouth for **FY 2006**; and

**WHEREAS**, the County is making some of these funds available to certain participating municipalities and non-profit agencies; and

**WHEREAS**, it is required that the **Borough of Red Bank** execute a project agreement with Monmouth County to undertake a project known as **Bassett Place Reconstruction**; and

**WHEREAS**, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development is requiring that the Mayor of the **Borough of Red Bank** sign additional certifications in order to receive these funds; and

**WHEREAS**, the **Borough of Red Bank** has adopted a policy prohibiting the use of excessive force by its law enforcement agency (police force) within its jurisdiction against any individuals engaged in non-violent civil rights demonstrations; and

**WHEREAS**, a copy of that policy is attached to and made part of this resolution;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the **Borough of Red Bank** has met the conditions of receiving a **FY 2006** allocation by adopting a policy prohibiting the use of excessive force and by not using federal funds for lobbying or by disclosing that funds have been used for lobbying;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Mayor of the **Borough of Red Bank** is hereby authorized to sign the attached certifications which will become part of the **FY 2006** Project Agreement.
