RESOLUTION NO. 08-120

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE BOROUGH CLERK TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY, ACTING THROUGH THE COMMISSIONER OF TRANSPORTATION, REGARDING THE INSTALLATION OF A SEMI-ACTUATED TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNAL, WITH PEDESTRIAN PUSHBUTTONS AND AREAS OF PRESENCE DETECTION AT THE INTERSECTION OF ROUTE 35 NORTH AND SOUTHBOUND (MAPLE AVENUE AND WATER STREET) AND WHITE STREET

Mr. Murphy offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, a traffic condition exists at the intersections of Route 35 North and Southbound (Maple Avenue and Water Street) and White Street within the Borough of Red Bank, in the County of Monmouth; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to expedite the safe movement and conduct of pedestrian and vehicular traffic; and

WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey has indicated its willingness to install a traffic control signal at said intersection and has proposed a form of Agreement pertaining to the maintenance of said traffic signal;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Red Bank of Red Bank that the Mayor and Borough Clerk are hereby authorized to enter into and execute an Agreement with the State of New Jersey, acting though its Commissioner of Transportation, for the purpose aforesaid, a copy of said agreement being attached hereto and made a part hereof.
