A RESOLUTION REQUESTING APPROVAL OF SPECIAL ITEM OF REVENUE

Mr. Murphy offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, N.J.S. 40A:4-87 provides that the Director of the Division of Local Government Services may approve the insertion of any special item of revenue in the budget of any county or municipality when such item shall have been made available by law and the amount thereof was not determined at the time of the adoption of the budget, and

WHEREAS, said Director may also approve the insertion of any item of appropriation for an equal amount, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Red Bank will receive funding from the New Jersey Division of Highway Traffic Safety **Over the Limit Under Arrest Mobilization Program** in the amount of \$5,000.00 and wish to amend its 2008 budget in the sum of \$5,000.00 which is now available as a revenue from:
