**RESOLUTION NO. 08-246**

**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE  
*OVER THE LIMIT UNDER ARREST 2008 YEAREND CRACKDOWN***

Mr. Murphy offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

**WHEREAS**, impaired drivers on our nation's roads kill someone every 30 minutes, 50 people per day, and almost 18,000 people each year; and

**WHEREAS**, 28% of motor vehicle fatalities in New Jersey are alcohol-related; and

**WHEREAS**, an enforcement crackdown is planned to combat impaired driving; and

**WHEREAS**, the holiday season is traditionally a time of social gatherings which often include alcohol; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of New Jersey, Division of Highway Traffic Safety, has asked law enforcement agencies throughout the state to participate in the *Over the Limit Under Arrest 2008 Yearend Crackdown*; and

**WHEREAS**, the project will involve increased impaired driving enforcement from December 8, 2008 to January 2, 2009; and

**WHEREAS**, an increase in impaired driving enforcement and a reduction in impaired driving will save lives on our roadways;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Red Bank that they declare their support of the *Over the Limit Under Arrest 2008 Yearend Crackdown* from December 8, 2008 to January 2, 2009 and pledge to increase awareness of the dangers of drinking and driving.
