RESOLUTION NO. 08-265

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE BOROUGH ATTORNEY, THE MAYOR AND THE BOROUGH CLERK TO PREPARE AND EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH C3 CITIZEN COMMUNICATION CENTER TO PROVIDE WEB DEVELOPMENT AND ELECTRONIC CITIZEN NOTIFICATION SERVICES

Ms. Horgan offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. §40A:11-5(1)(dd) permits the Borough to award a contract for the provision or performance of goods or services for the support or maintenance of propriety computer hardware and software without competitive bids; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Red Bank seeks to obtain web design services and to further establish an electronic citizen notification system for both emergency and non-emergency matters; and

WHEREAS, C3 Citizen Communication Center has submitted a proposal to provide such services through the use of its own patented technology to the Borough of Red Bank in accordance with a proposal dated September 3, 2008 and at a cost of \$2,000.00 per month; and

WHEREAS, the Borough desires to enter into an agreement with C3 Citizen Communication Center in accordance with the above-described proposal;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Red Bank as follows:

- a. The Borough Attorney is hereby authorized to prepare a contract with C3 Citizens Communications to implement the terms and conditions of C3's September 3, 2008 proposal, and such other conditions deemed reasonable and necessary, at a price not to exceed \$2,000.00 per month; and
- b. The Mayor and Borough Clerk are hereby authorized to execute such contract with C3 Citizen Communication Center under the terms and conditions described above and review and approval by the Borough Attorney.
