

ORDINANCE NO. 2008-9

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF RED BANK,
COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY
AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING
CHAPTER IXX, "SANITATION,"
SECTION 19-10.3, "NONRESIDENTIAL COLLECTION"

BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Red Bank that Chapter IXX of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Red Bank, Monmouth County, "Sanitation," Section 19-10.3, "Nonresidential Collection," is hereby amended and supplemented as follows:

SECTION ONE:

Section 19-10.3, "Non-Residential Collection" is amended and supplemented as follows (strikeouts denote deletions, underlined text denotes additions):

19-10.3 Nonresidential Collection.

- a. *Solid Waste Collection.* Nonresidential properties will be provided solid waste pick-up two (2) days per week of up to three (3) trash cans as described in subsection 19-10.5a.
- b. *Greater Level of Service.* Nonresidential properties which the Borough determines require a greater level of service than provided in paragraph a. above, must contract with an approved private solid waste collector for their entire solid waste collection.
- c. *Public and Non-Taxpaying Properties.* Municipal and local public entities' and agencies' buildings, fire houses, and first aid squads ~~and all elementary and secondary schools~~ in the Borough shall receive solid waste collection ~~by~~ from the Borough or its agents on a schedule to be determined by the Department of Public Utilities. All ~~other public buildings~~ and non-taxpaying properties shall be considered nonresidential properties for the purposes of this section.

[All other provisions remain unchanged]

SECTION TWO: Any ordinances or portions thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as of the effective date of this Ordinance.

SECTION THREE: If any provision of this Ordinance or the application of such provision to any person or circumstance is declared invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect, and to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION FOUR: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption according to law.
