

ORDINANCE NO. 2008-22

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF RED BANK,
COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY
AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING
CHAPTER II, "ADMINISTRATION"

**SECTION 2-36.7, "ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE OF POLICE DEPARTMENT AND
RESPONSIBILITIES OF COMMAND WITHIN DEPARTMENT"**

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has made a recommendation to the Governing Body with regard to the maximum number of ranking officers within the Borough of Red Bank and the Governing Body is agreeable to this recommendation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Red Bank as follows:

SECTION ONE: Chapter II, "Administration", Article V, "Departments" Section 2.36 "Police Department", Subsection 2.36.7(b) of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Red Bank is amended to read as follows (*strikeouts denote deletions, underlined text denote additions*):

2-36.7 Organizational Structure of Police Department and Responsibilities of Command Within Department.

- a. *[No Change]*
- b. Responsibility of Command and Membership within the Department.
 1. The order of rank and the authorized number in the Police Department will be as follows:

Chief of Police: One (1)
Deputy Chief of Police: ~~One~~(1) None.
Captains: ~~Two~~ (2) Four (4)
Lieutenants: Five (5)
Sergeants: ~~Eight~~ (8) Seven (7)
Detectives: (As many as the Chief of Police deems necessary subject to the approval of the Mayor and Council).
Patrolman: (As many as the Mayor and Council deems necessary).
Command shall be exercised by the virtue of rank, and in cases of equal rank, by length of service in such rank; and where equal, by length of service in the preceding rank.

[All other provisions remain unchanged]

SECTION TWO: Any ordinances or portions thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as of the effective date of this Ordinance.

SECTION THREE: If any provision of this Ordinance or the application of such provision to any person or circumstance is declared invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect, and to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION FOUR: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption according to law.
