**RESOLUTION ACKNOWLEDGING THE EFFORTS OF  
BOROUGH OF RED BANK 2020 COMPLETE COUNT COMMITTEE**

**WHEREAS**, the U.S. Census Bureau is required by the U.S. Constitution to conduct a count of the population every ten years, and this decennial count provides a historic opportunity to help shape the foundation of our society and play an active role in American democracy; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Red Bank is committed to ensuring that every resident is counted and, to further that goal, established a 2020 Complete Count Committee on December 11, 2019 to partner with the U.S. Census Bureau to help ensure a full and accurate count; and

**WHEREAS**, U.S. Census Bureau had a statutory deadline of December 31, 2020 to complete the census and is expected to deliver population counts by April 1, 2021 or as close to that date as possible.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Red Bank to thank the members of the Complete Count Committee for their participation and concerted efforts to ensure an accurate count of our community. Their efforts helped the Borough achieve a response rate of almost 70 percent. The Governing Body and the residents of Red Bank thank them for their dedication and hard work to help reach this goal.
