

PROCLAMATION

BOROUGH OF RED BANK

WHEREAS, EVERY DAY MORE THAN 100 AMERICANS ARE KILLED BY GUN VIOLENCE AND, ON AVERAGE, THERE ARE NEARLY 13,000 GUN HOMICIDES IN EVERY YEAR; AND

WHEREAS, AMERICANS ARE 25 TIMES MORE LIKELY TO BE KILLED WITH GUNS THAN PEOPLE IN OTHER DEVELOPED COUNTRIES; AND

WHEREAS, PROTECTING PUBLIC SAFETY IN THE COMMUNITIES THEY SERVE IS THE MAYORS' HIGHEST RESPONSIBILITY; AND

WHEREAS, SUPPORT FOR THE SECOND AMENDMENT RIGHTS OF LAW-ABIDING CITIZENS GOES HAND-IN-HAND WITH KEEPING GUNS AWAY FROM DANGEROUS PEOPLE; AND

WHEREAS, MAYORS AND LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS KNOW THEIR COMMUNITIES BEST, ARE THE MOST FAMILIAR WITH LOCAL CRIMINAL ACTIVITY AND HOW TO ADDRESS IT AND ARE BEST POSITIONED TO UNDERSTAND HOW TO KEEP THEIR CITIZENS SAFE; AND

WHEREAS, IN JANUARY 2013 HADIYA PENDLETON, A TEENAGER WHO MARCHED IN PRESIDENT OBAMA'S SECOND INAUGURAL PARADE AND WAS TRAGICALLY SHOT AND KILLED JUST WEEKS LATER, SHOULD NOW CELEBRATING HER 21ST BIRTHDAY, AND

WHEREAS, TO HELP HONOR HADIYA—AND THE 100 PLUS AMERICANS WHOSE LIVES ARE CUT SHORT AND THE COUNTLESS SURVIVORS WHO ARE INJURED BY SHOOTINGS EVERY DAY—A NATIONAL COALITION OF ORGANIZATIONS HAS DESIGNATED THE FIRST FRIDAY IN JUNE, AS NATIONAL GUN VIOLENCE AWARENESS DAY; AND

WHEREAS, THE IDEA WAS INSPIRED BY A GROUP OF HADIYA'S FRIENDS WHO ASKED THEIR CLASSMATES TO COMMEMORATE HER LIFE BY WEARING ORANGE; THEY CHOSE THIS COLOR BECAUSE HUNTERS WEAR ORANGE TO ANNOUNCE THEMSELVES TO OTHER HUNTERS WHEN OUT IN THE WOODS AND ORANGE IS THE COLOR THAT SYMBOLIZES HUMAN LIFE; AND

WHEREAS, ANYONE CAN JOIN THIS CAMPAIGN BY PLEDGING TO WEAR ORANGE ON JUNE 5TH¹, THE FIRST FRIDAY IN JUNE 2020, TO HELP PRAISE AWARENESS ABOUT GUN VIOLENCE; AND

WHEREAS, BY WEARING ORANGE ON JUNE 5, 2020 AMERICANS WILL RAISE AWARENESS ABOUT GUN VIOLENCE AND HONOR THE LIVES OF GUN VIOLENCE VICTIMS AND SURVIVORS; AND

WHEREAS, WE RENEW OUR COMMITMENT TO REDUCE GUN VIOLENCE AND PLEDGE TO DO ALL WE CAN TO KEEP FIREARMS OUT OF THE WRONG HANDS, AND TO ENCOURAGE RESPONSIBLE GUN OWNERSHIP TO HELP KEEP OUR CHILDREN SAFE.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED THAT I, PASQUALE MENNA, MAYOR OF THE BOROUGH OF RED BANK HEREBY PROCLAIM THAT FRIDAY, JUNE 5, 2020 IS **NATIONAL GUN VIOLENCE AWARENESS DAY** IN THE BOROUGH OF RED BANK AND I ENCOURAGE ALL CITIZENS TO SUPPORT THEIR LOCAL COMMUNITIES' EFFORTS TO PREVENT THE TRAFFIC EFFECTS OF GUN VIOLENCE AND TO HONOR AND VALUE HUMAN LIVES.
