A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF RED BANK, COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY CALLING FOR MONMOUTH COUNTY TO IMPLEMENT SAFE PEDESTRIAN CROSSWALKS ON SHREWSBURY AVENUE BETWEEN NEWMAN SPRINGS ROAD AND MONMOUTH STREET

WHEREAS, County Route 13 (Shrewsbury Avenue) is a densely developed and thriving residential and business corridor traversing the Borough of Red Bank with significant pedestrian and bicycle traffic; and

WHEREAS, County Route 13 and the adjacent streets have a mix of business and residential uses and it is heavily travelled by pedestrian traffic on a daily basis; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Red Bank are deeply concerned about pedestrian safety along this thoroughfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Red Bank that the Borough strongly supports Monmouth County implementing Safe Pedestrian Crosswalks on Shrewsbury Avenue between Newman Springs Road and Monmouth Street.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution shall be forwarded by the Clerk to the appropriate officials in Monmouth County.
