A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF RED BANK, COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE
OF NEW JERSEY CALLING FOR MONMOUTH COUNTY TO IMPLEMENT SAFE
PEDESTRIAN CROSSWALKS AT THE INTERSECTION BROAD STREET AND
PINCKNEY ROAD

WHEREAS, County Route 11 (Broad Street) and County Route 520 (Pinckney Road) are densely developed and thriving residential and business corridors traversing the Borough of Red Bank with significant pedestrian traffic; and

WHEREAS, County Route 11 and County Route 520 and the adjacent streets have a mix of business and residential uses and it is heavily travelled by pedestrian traffic on a daily basis; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Red Bank are deeply concerned about pedestrian safety along this thoroughfare and specifically at this intersection of Broad Street and Pinckney Road.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Red Bank that the Borough strongly supports Monmouth County conducting a traffic study and implementing Safe Pedestrian Crosswalks at Broad Street and Pinckney Road. This would include the consideration of whether the intersection meets the warrants for a traffic signal.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution shall be forwarded by the Clerk to the appropriate officials in Monmouth County.
