RESOLUTION TEMPORARILY DESIGNATING A PORTION OF BROAD STREET AS A
PEDESTRIAN MALL AKA “BROADWALK” AT CERTAIN TIMES

WHEREAS, residents of the Borough of Red Bank have expressed an interest in continuing “Broadwalk” project within the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Council proposes has established an Ad Hoc Committee on the “Broadwalk” project to initiate strategic planning, to recommend potential policies, procedures, and initiatives related to the project, and to ensure an effective means of liaising with the Administration, as well as local businesses, residents and groups committed to similar actions within the borough for 2022; and

WHEREAS, this has thoroughly reviewed the project and met with various stakeholders for input; the committee’s recommendations for 2022 are as follows:

- 1. Broadwalk participants will be charged a Monthly fee of \$2.25/square foot of space utilized within the designated broad walk that is considered Borough property, to include (but not limited to) parking spots, loading zones and roadways.
- 2. Broadwalk will operate seven (7) days per week from July 18 (or as soon Broad Street is available) thru Labor Day ONLY for 2022. Broad Street (from Front Street to White Street) shall be closed to vehicular traffic from 8:00AM to 10:00PM from Sunday to Thursday and from 8:00AM to 11:00PM on Fridays and Saturdays, for the purposes of creating a pedestrian mall during such time period.
- 3. The Broad walk committee will remain intact after Labor Day to continue working with River Center to discuss long-range plans of the broad walk concept in Red Bank.
- 4. The Outdoor Business Extension is subject to §562 Sidewalk Cafes and Restaurants and subject to all conditions set forth in any Ordinance or Resolution heretofore adopted by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Red Bank
