WHEREAS, Tom was elected to the Red Bank Borough Council in 1974 where he would serve the town for over 30 years in many capacities including Police Commissioner; and

WHEREAS, with heartfelt gratitude the Council and Community recognize the many contributions of Thomas E. Hintelmann and the lives he positively impacted.
