“Trinity Episcopal Church Rededication Day”

WHEREAS, Trinity Episcopal Church was founded as a congregation in 1834 and designated a parish in 1859, making it the oldest congregation in the Borough of Red Bank; and

WHEREAS, the oldest parts of the building date to 1851 with major expansions in 1868, 1956, 1964, and 1969; and

WHEREAS, the exterior of the Bell-Tower, Church, and Parish Hall has in recent years suffered significant degradation from water and wind damage leaving the future of the same in jeopardy; and

WHEREAS, in this nation it has long been recognized that our spiritual life must be an integral part of our everyday existence. The Trinity Episcopal Church family has demonstrated their belief in this basic tenet, as well as our community, by the restoration to the building to its historical design as a house of worship and a center for community events and outreach; and

WHEREAS, in Psalm 127 it says, “Unless the Lord builds the house, they labor in vain who build it;” and

WHEREAS, on the occasion of this joyous fulfillment the service of dedication should provide an opportunity for worship, for praise, for recognition of workers, and for Godly guidance.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Pasquale Menna, Mayor of the Borough of Rd Bank, do hereby proclaim Saturday, June 11, 2022, as:
