WHEREAS, as more and more health professionals become proficient in diagnosing autism, more children are being diagnosed on the autistic spectrum, resulting in rates as low as one in 500 children; and

WHEREAS, while there is no cure for autism, it is well-documented that if an individual with autism receives treatment early in their lives, it is often possible for that individual to make significant improvement; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Center for Outreach and Services for the Autism Community (COSAC) is spearheading an awareness effort in order to educate parents, professionals, and the general public about autism and its effects;
