DEDICATION OF EAST SIDE PARK PAVILION IN MEMORY OF JOHN CASH

WHEREAS, an active member of the Borough of Red Bank, Mr. John Cash exemplified “civic duty”; serving in revitalization efforts, preservation, and serving on the Red Bank Planning Board for over 20 years, with the past 15 years as Chairman; and

WHEREAS, John Cash, an advocate of East Side Park was instrumental in establishing a permanent park building complete with permanent restroom facilities for young athletes and park visitors; and

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Committee has discussed the dedication and recommends that the East Side Park Pavilion be named the John Cash Park Pavilion in recognition of Mr. Cash’s selfless dedication and devotion to the citizens of the Borough of Red Bank.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council that authorization is hereby given to name the East Side Park Pavilion in memory of John Cash; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a memorial plaque may be placed at the location of the Park Pavilion to be named John Cash Park Pavilion.
