WHEREAS, Robert Talerico, born and raised in Red Bank, joined the Navesink Hook and Ladder of the Red Bank Volunteer Fire Department in November 1973: and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Red Bank Fire Department was first organized in 1872, and the Navesink Hook and Ladder Company was incorporated in 1873 by an act of the New Jersey State Legislature; and

WHEREAS, Robert Talerico has served the Red Bank community as a volunteer firefighter for over fifty years including as Chief of the Department in 1994 and as Acting Chief in 2006, as Captain of the Hook & Ladder, as President of the Hook & Ladder, as a member of the Borough's Fire Marshalls Office from 1999-2017, as a life member of the New Jersey Firemen's Relief Association, and is the recipient of numerous awards for his service including twice being honored as Red Bank's Fire Fighter of the Year; and

WHEREAS, Robert Talerico, served his Nation for four years as a member of the United States Navy, returned home and joined the fire department, and continues to serve Red Bank in a manner all residents and Department members should be proud to emulate; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Red Bank, recognize with gratitude Robert Talerico's significant service and contributions to our community's safety and the Red Bank Volunteer Fire Department.
