ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF RED BANK, COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING SECTION 680-60, SCHEDULE XXVI:  
RESTRICTED PARKING FOR HANDICAPPED PERSONS

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Governing Body of the Borough of Red Bank that Section 680-60, Schedule XXVI: **RESTRICTED PARKING FOR HANDICAPPED PERSONS**, is hereby amended and supplemented as follows: (*strikeouts denote deletions, underlined text denotes additions*):

**SCHEDULE XXVI**

**B. Private Properties**

Name	Location
44 Drummond Avenue	North side of Drummond Avenue, beginning at a point 150 feet east of intersection with S. Bridge Avenue and extending 25 feet therefrom in an easterly direction.

*[All other provisions remain unchanged]*

**SECTION TWO:** Any ordinances or portions thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as of the effective date of this Ordinance.

**SECTION THREE:** If any provision of this Ordinance or the application of such provision to any person or circumstance is declared invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect, and to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

**SECTION FOUR:** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption according to law.
