RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF RED BANK , IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, REQUESTING A COST SHARE AGREEMENT BETWEEN NJDOT AND THE BOROUGH OF RED BANK FOR ADDITIONAL MARKED CROSSWALKS ON ROUTE 35

WHEREAS, the Borough of Red Bank has requested the installation of additional marked crosswalks on Route 35 between Monmouth Street and Bergen Place; specifically at Gold Street, Oakland Street, Leroy Place and Irving Place; and the installation of an activated flasher at the intersection of Route 35 and Reckless Place, located in the Borough of Red Bank; and

WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey Department of Transportation responded by requesting a 25% cost-sharing agreement to be signed by the Borough of Red; and


WHEREAS, the Red Bank Borough Council believes this project to be in the best interest of the community as it will make the intersections safer.

WHEREAS, as per NJDOT Policy 346, the Borough is willing to contribute up to a 25% cost share for these projects.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Borough Council of Red Bank does request the NJDOT's Bureau of Traffic Engineering to complete the warrant analysis and design work for the installation of additional marked crosswalks on Route 35 between Monmouth Street and Bergen Place; specifically at Gold Street, Oakland Street, Leroy Place and Irving Place; and the installation of an activated flasher at the intersection of Route 35 and Reckless Place if warranted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Red Bank , County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey that:

1. A copy of this resolution be forwarded to the New Jersey Department of Transportation.
2. This resolution was passed unanimously by the Borough Council.
3. This resolution was supported by many residents of Maple Avenue (SR35).
