**AUTHORIZING ENGINEERING SCOPE OF WORK FOR PROJECT KNOWN AS  
MONMOUTH STREET PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS**

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Governing Body has identified a need to approve the engineering scope of work for survey, base map, design phase and bid phase services provided by CME Associates for the Monmouth Street Pedestrian Improvements Project; and,

**WHEREAS**, The project includes streetscape improvements on Monmouth Street from Broad Street to Shrewsbury Avenue. The total length of improvements is approximately 3,100 linear feet, and includes replacement of concrete curb, concrete driveway aprons, concrete sidewalk, brick paver sidewalk, and drainage improvements; and,

**WHEREAS**, the estimated cost of construction is approximately \$895,000.00. It should be noted that Borough was awarded a FY2022 NJDOT Safe Street to Transit grant in the amount of \$675,000.00 for said improvements.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Red Bank, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, that the scope of work for survey, base map, design phase and bid phase services provided by CME Associates in the amount of \$44,500 and,

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this Resolution shall take effect upon certification on this Resolution by the Borough Chief Financial Officer that sufficient funds are available for the stated purpose.
