Marine Park Improvement Project Update – Borough Administrator

-borough engineer Michael Reiser gave an update on Marine Park, phase 1 construction

phase 2 remaining amenities, entry plaza, water feature on union street, plaza area, relocating playground, landscaping improvement, rain garden

-phase 1 out to bid, process opens next week, phase 1 includes first constructing new parking lot and then converting existing parking lot to green space

-assume a few weeks to get bonds in place and confirm contracts, hope construction can begin in May or June, hoping to complete phase 1 in August

-committee members were able to ask questions about the project and plan to execute
