ORDINANCE NO. 2024-33

**ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 85: “MAYOR AND COUNCIL” OF THE
BOROUGH’S REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES TO INCLUDE DISCRETIONARY
PROJECT/POLICY/ISSUE-SPECIFIC COMMITTEES OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Red Bank, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, that Chapter 85: “Mayor and Council” of the Borough’s Revised General Ordinances is amended to include *new* Section 85-6 as follows:

CHAPTER 85: “MAYOR AND COUNCIL”


§ 85-6 **Committees of the Borough Council.**

- A. The Borough Council shall generally act in all matters as a body and shall address the administrative services of the Borough solely through the Borough Manager.
- B. The Borough Council may, from time-to-time and as circumstances may require, in its sole discretion, appoint such legislative, investigatory, problem-solving, policy-driven, or project-based committees or commissions of its own members or of Borough citizens, or both, to assist the Borough Council in the conduct of its decision-making, general business and other governmental and civic affairs.
- C. The Borough Council may delegate to such committees or commissions such powers of inquiry as it may deem necessary and as may be authorized by law.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that any ordinances or portions thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as of the effective date of this Ordinance. All other provisions of the Revised General Ordinances are ratified and remain in full force and effect.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that if any provision of this Ordinance or the application of such provision to any person or circumstance is declared invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect, and to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption and publication in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey.
