The program adopts its criteria from the New Jersey Sustainable Business Registry (NJSBR), encouraging our businesses to enact sustainable initiatives at a level meriting both local and state recognition.

Program Goals:

- Waste management and reduction

- Reduced energy and water consumption
- Sustainable construction and development
- Community and social responsibility

About the NJSBR:

Our program borrows its recognition criteria from the NJSBR, established by the New Jersey Sustainable Business Initiative.

- Once your registration is accepted, you will be given an online listing and you’re ready to apply for Red Bank’s local program, as well
