The EC encourages homeowners and project landscape architects to take the following information into account when deciding on the plants for the yards.

Juniperus virginiana - Eastern Red-Cedar
Liquidambar styraciflua - Sweetgum (Large shade tree)
Nyssa sylvatica - Blackgum (Large shade tree)

Sassafras albidum – Sassafras (Medium shade tree)

Quercus alba - White Oak (Large shade tree)

Quercus rubra - Red Oak (Large shade tree)

Quercus montana - Chestnut Oak (Large shade tree)
