

ORDINANCE NO. 2017- 14

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF RED BANK,
COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY
AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 478, PARKS AND RECREATION,
ARTICLE 1: PUBLIC WATERS AND BOATS, SECTION 478-7 FISHING

Councilman Yngstrom offered the following ordinance and moved its adoption:

BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Red Bank that Chapter 478 of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Red Bank, Monmouth County, “Parks and Recreation” is hereby amended and supplemented as follows:

SECTION ONE: Article 1: Public Waters and Boats, Section 478-7 Fishing is hereby amended and supplemented as follows (stricken text denotes deletions, underlined text denotes additions):

There shall be no fishing except from Mohawk Pond or the public fishing pier.

SECTION TWO: Any ordinances or portions thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as of the effective date of this Ordinance. All other provisions of the Revised General Ordinances are ratified and remain in full force and effect.

SECTION THREE: If any provision of this Ordinance or the application of such provision to any person or circumstance is declared invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect, and to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION FOUR: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption according to law.
