

ORDINANCE NO. 2017-30

**ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF RED BANK, COUNTY OF MONMOUTH,
NEW JERSEY AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 680: "VEHICLES AND
TRAFFIC," SECTION 680-44 SCHEDULE X: "LOADING ZONES"**

Councilman Zipprich offered the following ordinance and moved its adoption:

BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Red Bank that Chapter VII of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Red Bank, Monmouth County, "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC," Section 680-44 Schedule X: "Loading Zones," is hereby amended and supplemented as follows:

SECTION ONE: Schedule X: "Loading Zones," is amended and supplemented as follows: (*strikeouts denote deletions, underlined text denotes additions*):

Schedule X: Loading Zones

In accordance with the provisions of Subsection 680-7A of this chapter, the following described locations are hereby designated as loading zones:

Name of Street	Side	Location
White Street	South	From a point beginning 130 feet west of the intersection with the west side of Broad Street and running 98 feet west from the beginning point.

[All other provisions remain unchanged]

SECTION TWO: Any ordinances or portions thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as of the effective date of this Ordinance.

SECTION THREE: If any provision of this Ordinance or the application of such provision to any person or circumstance is declared invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect, and to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION FOUR: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption according to law.
