

ORDINANCE NO. 2017-40

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF RED BANK, MONMOUTH COUNTY AMENDING CHAPTER 695 "WATER AND SEWER", ARTICLE III "WATER DEPARTMENT" SECTION 695-6 "WATER RATES" THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF RED BANK

Councilman Zipprich offered the following ordinance and moved its adoption:

BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Red Bank that Chapter 695 "Water and Sewer", of the revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Red Bank is amended and supplemented as follows:

SECTION ONE: Article III "Water Department", Section 695-6 "Water Rates" is amended and supplemented to read as follows:

695-6 A. Water Rates. The minimum water rates to be charged per quarter, by the Borough shall be as follows (deletions ~~stricken~~, additions underlined):

(1) Minimum water rates.

SECTION TWO: Any ordinances or portions thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as of the effective date of this Ordinance. All other provisions of Chapter 695 "Water and Sewer" are ratified and remain in full force and effect.

SECTION THREE: If any provision of this Ordinance or the application of such provision to any person or circumstance is declared invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect, and to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION FOUR: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption according to law.
