

ORDINANCE NO. 2015-19

ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER VII, "TRAFFIC",
Section 7-6.2 "STOP INTERSECTIONS", Schedule VIII, "STOP INTERSECTIONS",
OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF RED BANK

Councilwoman Burnham offered the following ordinance and moved its adoption on final reading:

BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Red Bank that Chapter VII, "Traffic", Section 7-6.2 "Stop Intersections", Schedule VIII "Stop Intersections", of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Red Bank, be amended and supplemented as follows:

SECTION ONE: Section 7-6.2 "Stop Intersections", Schedule VIII "Stop Intersections" of Article VII ("Traffic") of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Red Bank is amended and supplemented as follows (stricken text denotes deletions, underlined text denotes additions):

SCHEDULE VIII
STOP INTERSECTIONS

In accordance with the provisions of Subsection 7-6.2, the following intersection is hereby designated as a Stop Intersection:

Garfield Place and Grant Place:

Stop sign to be installed on Garfield Place.

SECTION TWO: Any ordinances or portions thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as of the effective date of this Ordinance.

SECTION THREE: If any provision of this Ordinance or the application of such provision to any person or circumstance is declared invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect, and to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION FOUR: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption according to law.
