

ORDINANCE NO. 2015-20

ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER VII, "TRAFFIC",
Section 7-10.4 "LANE USE RESERVATIONS", Schedule XVI,
"LANE USE RESERVATIONS", OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES
OF THE BOROUGH OF RED BANK

Councilman DuPont offered the following ordinance and moved its adoption on final reading:

BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Red Bank that Chapter VII, "Traffic", Section 7-10.4 "Lane Use Reservations", Schedule XVI "Lane Use Reservations", of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Red Bank, be amended and supplemented as follows:

SECTION ONE: Section 7-10.4 "Lane Use Reservations", Schedule XVI "Lane Use Reservations", of Article VII ("Traffic") of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Red Bank is amended and supplemented as follows (stricken text denotes deletions, underlined text denotes additions):

**SCHEDULE XVI
LANE USE RESERVATION**

In accordance with Subsection 7-10.4, all vehicles shall move as described in the following locations:

- Broad Street
On the northerly approach to Harding Road the left lane shall be for left turns only.
- Broad Street
On the southerly approach to Harding Road the left lane shall be for left turns only.
- Broad Street
On the southerly approach to Linden Place the left lane shall be for left turns only.
- Broad Street
On northerly approach to Monmouth Street the left lane shall be for left turns only.
- Broad Street
On southerly approach to Monmouth Street the right lane shall be for right turns only.
- Broad Street
On northerly approach to East Front Street right lane shall be right turns only and left lane shall be for left turns only.

SECTION TWO: Any ordinances or portions thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as of the effective date of this Ordinance.

SECTION THREE: If any provision of this Ordinance or the application of such provision to any person or circumstance is declared invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect, and to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION FOUR: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption according to law.
