

ORDINANCE NO. 2014-15

**ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER VII, "TRAFFIC", OF THE
REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF RED BANK
TO ESTABLISH TOW-AWAY ZONES**

Councilman DuPont offered the following ordinance and moved its adoption on final reading:

BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Red Bank that Chapter VII, "Traffic", be amended and supplemented as follows to add the following new provision regarding the establishment of tow-away zones:

SECTION ONE: the following provision shall be added to Chapter VII, "Traffic" of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Red Bank:

Tow-Away Zones:

The following streets and locations are hereby designated as tow away zones. Any Vehicle parked or standing as to obstruct or impede a normal flow of traffic, block entrances or exit ways, including driveways, pedestrian walk ways, or present in any way a safety or traffic hazard may be removed by the towing of said vehicle at the owner or operator's expense, within the discretion of the Borough of Red Bank Police Department, pursuant to Title 39 and the Borough of Red Bank Ordinances:

1. Chestnut Street, from Maple Avenue to West Street;
2. Oakland Street, from Maple Avenue to West Street;
3. Pearl Street, from Chestnut Street to Monmouth Street.

SECTION TWO: Any ordinances or portions thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as of the effective date of this Ordinance. All other provisions of Chapter VII "Traffic" of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Red Bank are ratified and remain in full force and effect.

SECTION THREE: If any provision of this Ordinance or the application of such provision to any person or circumstance is declared invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect, and to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION FOUR: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption according to law.
