

**ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF RED BANK,
COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY
AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING
CHAPTER VII, "TRAFFIC", SECTION 7-3 "PARKING" OF
THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF RED BANK,
RESERVED PARKING FOR ELECTRIC CHARGING VEHICLES**

Councilman Murphy offered the following ordinance and moved its adoption on final reading:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Red Bank that Chapter VII of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Red Bank, Monmouth County, "Traffic", Section 7-3 "Parking", "Reserved Parking for Electric Charging Vehicles", is hereby amended and supplemented as follows:

SECTION ONE: Section 7-3 of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Red Bank, subsection entitled "Reserved Parking for Electric Charging Vehicles", is hereby amended and supplemented to as follows (stricken text denotes deletions, underlined text denotes additions):

As used in this section, the following terms shall have the meanings indicated:

ELECTRIC VEHICLE means any car, truck or other vehicle that does not produce a tailpipe or evaporative emissions or is a plug-in hybrid electric vehicle (PHEV).

RESERVED PARKING FOR RECHARGING OF ELECTRIC VEHICLE means any parking spaced designated by the Borough for the recharging of an Electric Vehicle.

Reserved Parking for Electric Charging Vehicles

A. It shall be unlawful for any person to park or leave standing a vehicle in a stall or space designated for the recharging of electric vehicles unless the vehicle is connected for electric charging purposes.

B. It shall be unlawful for any person to obstruct, block, or otherwise bar access to parking stalls or spaces described in Subsection A except as provided in Subsection A.

C. Notice of Parking spaces for reserved parking for recharging of electric vehicles shall designated and identified by green pavement and/or curb markings, a green painted charging pictograph symbol and appropriate signage. be posted on a sign not less than 17 inches by 22 inches in size with lettering not less than one inch in height that clearly and conspicuously states the following: "Unauthorized vehicles not connected for electric charging purposes may be towed away at owner's expense. Towed vehicles may be reclaimed at designated towing facility or by calling the Red Bank Police Department 732-". The sign shall be posted in both of the following locations:

(1)

Immediately adjacent to, and visible from, the stall or space.

(2)

In a conspicuous place at each entrance to any parking facility where such space is located.

D. Designation of Reserved Parking Space for Recharging of Electric Vehicle – The first Reserved Parking Space for the Recharging of Electric Vehicles designated by the Borough shall be located on the north side of Monmouth Street adjacent to Borough Hall at 90 Monmouth Street. The Governing Body may designate such additional Reserved Parking Spaces For Recharging of Electric Vehicles as it deems necessary and appropriate and said designation can be effectuated by a Resolution adopted by the Governing Body and provided

that any space so designated complies with all of the requirements of this Ordinance.

E. Fees- The fees to be charged by the Borough for the use of a space or stall designated as Reserved Parking for Recharging of Electric Vehicle shall be \$2.00 per hour. This fee may be amended by a Resolution adopted by the Governing Body.

SECTION TWO: Any ordinances or portions thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as of the effective date of this Ordinance.

SECTION THREE: If any provision of this Ordinance or the application of such provision to any person or circumstance is declared invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect, and to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION FOUR: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption according to law.
