

ORDINANCE NO. 2013-9

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF RED BANK,
COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY
AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING
CHAPTER XVI, "FIRE PREVENTION AND PROTECTION"
SECTION 16-10, "TECHNICAL AMENDMENTS"

Councilman DuPont offered the following ordinance on final reading and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, the rebuilding effort in the areas of New Jersey that were significantly damaged by Super Storm Sandy is vitally important to all residents of the State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, volunteers from around the country, and in some cases, from outside the country are planning to come to New Jersey to assist with the rebuilding efforts, and

WHEREAS, the Governing body of Red Bank has amended its local ordinances to provide for a permit and inspection process for such activity, and

WHEREAS, there is a need to amend the adopted ordinance;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Red Bank that Chapter XVI of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Red Bank, Monmouth County, "Fire Prevention and Protection" is hereby amended and supplemented as follows:

SECTION ONE: Section 16-8, "Additional Required Inspections and Fees Required by the New Jersey Administrative Code"; Section 16-9, "Registration; Permits; Fees", and Section 16-10, "Technical Amendments" are amended and supplemented to the following extent (*strikeouts denote deletions, double underlined text denote additions*):

16-10 TECHNICAL AMENDMENTS.

The following additional local technical amendments are made to Subchapter 3 - State Fire Prevention Code pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:71-2.8 (a):

Amend Section F-409.15 3 by adding new item 12. as follows:

F-409.15.3 Application. Each application for a permit shall include a fire safety and evacuation plan which shall include, but not be limited to the following information:

1. Through 11. **No Change**
12. **Provide details as to food preparation/cooking facilities including existing or proposed cooking appliances and kitchen fire protection systems & equipment.**

SECTION TWO: Any ordinances or portions thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as of the effective date of this Ordinance.

SECTION THREE: If any provision of this Ordinance or the application of such provision to any person or circumstance is declared invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect, and to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION FOUR: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption according to law.

SECTION FIVE: The provisions of this Ordinance shall automatically expire on May 31, 2015, unless specifically extended by a Resolution of the Mayor and Council.
