

ORDINANCE NO. 2011-4

**ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF RED BANK,
COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY
AMENDING CHAPTER 4, GENERAL LICENSING, SECTION 4-6,
GAMES OF CHANCE ON SUNDAYS**

WHEREAS, the State Raffle Licensing Law, N.J.S.A. 5:8-50 et. seq. permits all games of chance to be held, operated or conducted in a municipality provided that a license is granted by the municipality; and

WHEREAS, N.J.A.C. 13:47-1.1 permits the governing body of a municipality to delegate, by ordinance, authority to a person to approve the granting of raffle licenses; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Red Bank, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, that Chapter 4, Section 4-6 of the Code of the Borough be amended as follows:

SECTION ONE:

Add as new Section, 4-6.2 “Games of Chance Approval Process”:

The Borough Clerk is hereby delegated the authority to act as the “issuing authority” for the purpose of approving the granting of licenses for games of chance.

SECTION TWO: Any ordinances or portions thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as of the effective date of this Ordinance. All other provisions of the traffic ordinance are ratified and remain in full force and effect.

SECTION THREE: If any provision of this Ordinance or the application of such provision to any person or circumstance is declared invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect, and to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION FOUR: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption according to law.
