**ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF RED BANK,
COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY
AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING
CHAPTER VII, "TRAFFIC"
SECTION 7-3.4 "PARKING PROHIBITED DURING CERTAIN HOURS
ON CERTAIN STREETS"
SCHEDULE II, OAKLAND STREET**

WHEREAS, the Traffic Bureau of the Police Department has conducted an examination of the drop-off and pick-up of students at the Red Bank Charter School and has recommend that certain changes be made to the parking regulations on Oakland Street to improve the safety and orderliness of that process; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Borough of Red Bank has determined that it is in the best interest of the Borough to adopt the recommendations of the Traffic Bureau in this regard. and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Red Bank that Chapter VII of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Red Bank, Monmouth County, "Traffic", Section 7-3.4 "Parking Prohibited During Certain Hours on Certain Streets", and Schedule II (Parking Prohibited Certain Hours) thereto, Oakland Street, is hereby amended as follows:

SCHEDULE II

PARKING PROHIBITED CERTAIN HOURS

Name of Street	Sides	Hours	Location
Oakland Street	North	7:00 a.m to 4:00 p.m. on legal school days	Beginning at a point 418 <u>25</u> feet west of the of the northwest corner of Pearl Street and extending westerly a distance along the northerly side of Oakland Street a distance of 302 <u>252</u> feet.

SECTION TWO: Any ordinances or portions thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as of the effective date of this Ordinance.

SECTION THREE: If any provision of this Ordinance or the application of such provision to any person or circumstance is declared invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect, and to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION FOUR: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final adoption.
