

ORDINANCE NO. 2010-19

ORDINANCE AMENDING
CHAPTER VII, "TRAFFIC",
SUBSECTION 7-7, "LOADING ZONES AND DROP OFF ZONES"
OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES
OF THE BOROUGH OF RED BANK

BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Red Bank that Chapter VII "Traffic", is amended and supplemented as follows:

SECTION ONE: Chapter VII, Subsection 7-7, Schedule X, "Loading Zones", is amended and supplemented as follows (*strikeouts denote deletions, underlined text denotes additions*):

7-7 LOADING ZONES AND DROP OFF ZONES.

7-7.1 Loading Zones. [...]

7-7.2 Drop Off Zones. The locations described in Schedule XXII, attached to and made a part of this Chapter, are hereby designated as Drop Off Zones. No person shall park a vehicle in said locations during the times indicated other than for the or for the letting off, or taking on, of passengers.

SECTION TWO: Chapter VII, Subsection 7-7, Schedule XXII, "Drop Off Zones", is amended and supplemented as follows (*strikeouts denote deletions, underlined text denotes additions*):

SCHEDULE XXII
DROP OFF ZONES

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Location</u>	<u>Times</u>
<u>Drs. James Parker Blvd.</u>	<u>North</u>	<u>Starting at a point 113 feet west of the northwest corner of Bridge Avenue and extending 70 feet in a westerly direction therefrom</u>	<u>Between the hours of 7 am-6 pm, Monday through Friday</u>

SECTION THREE: Any ordinances or portions thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as of the effective date of this Ordinance. All other provisions of the traffic ordinance are ratified and remain in full force and effect.

SECTION FOUR: If any provision of this Ordinance or the application of such provision to any person or circumstance is declared invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect, and to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION FIVE: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption according to law.
