

**ORDINANCE NO. 2010-1**

**ORDINANCE AMENDING  
CHAPTER II, "ADMINISTRATION",  
SUBSECTION 2-53, "HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION"  
OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF  
THE BOROUGH OF RED BANK TO PROVIDE  
FOR UP TO TWO ALTERNATE MEMBERS**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Governing Body of the Borough of Red Bank that Chapter II "Administration", is amended and supplemented as follows:

**SECTION ONE:** Chapter II, Subsection 2-53, "Historic Preservation Commission", is amended and supplemented as follows (*strikeouts denote deletions, double underlined text denote additions*):

**2-53.2 Membership.**

- a. The Red Bank Historic Preservation Commission shall consist of five (5) members and up to two ~~one~~ (1) alternates who shall be legal residents of the Borough of Red Bank during their term of their office, and shall be appointed by the Mayor with the advice and consent of the Borough Council of the Borough of Red Bank.
- b. At least one (1) member of the Planning Board, designated by Mayor and Council as that Board's representative to the Commission.
- c. The alternate members may participate in discussions of the proceedings, but may not vote except in the absence or disqualification of a regular member. A vote shall not be delayed in order that a regular member may vote instead of ~~the~~ an alternate member.

**SECTION TWO:** Any ordinances or portions thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as of the effective date of this Ordinance. All other provisions of the Revised General Ordinances are ratified and remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION THREE:** If any provision of this Ordinance or the application of such provision to any person or circumstance is declared invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect, and to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

**SECTION FOUR:** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption according to law.
