RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE BOROUGH OF RED BANK’S  
PURCHASING AGENT TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH  
ALERT AMBULANCE FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES

Councilman Zipprich offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Red Bank sought proposals for Emergency Medical Services for a contract period of two years; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough received two responses to the request for proposals.

- 1. Monmouth Ocean Hospital Service Corporation
- 2. Hackensack Meridian Health – Alert Ambulance

**WHEREAS**, the purchasing agent has determined the Hackensack Meridian Health – Alert Ambulance had the low proposal EMS services to the Borough on a 7 day a week/24 hour basis in the amount of \$120,000 per year; and

**WHEREAS**, the Purchasing Agent recommends that the Borough enter into a contract for Meridian Hackensack – Alert Ambulance for EMS services; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that sufficient funds are available for this contract.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Borough of Red Bank that the Borough’s Purchasing Agent is hereby authorized to execute a contract between Hackensack Meridian – Alert Ambulance and the Borough of Red Bank for EMS services from January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2018 in the amount of \$10,000 per month not to exceed \$120,000 per year.
