A RESOLUTION PETITIONING THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION
TO RESTRIPE AND INSTALL PEDESTRIAN SAFETY ENHANCEMENTS AT
THE EXISTING CROSSWALK LOCATED AT RIVERSIDE AVENUE
OPPOSITE VETERANS PARK NEAR PEARL STREET

Councilman Whelan offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, a crosswalk exists to convey pedestrian traffic across Riverside Avenue to Veterans Park near Pearl Street, in the Borough of Red Bank, in the County of Monmouth, which the Borough requests the NJDOT re-stripe and install pedestrian safety enhancements, including but not limited to advance warning signage and traffic beacons, in association with their resurfacing project of New Jersey State Highway Route 35 in order to minimize the possibility of accidents and improve pedestrian safety; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to expedite the establishment of safe movement and conduct of pedestrian and vehicular traffic; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Red Bank that requests that the New Jersey Department of Transportation take to necessary steps to immediately restripe and install pedestrian safety enhancements to maintain and improve the existing crosswalk along Riverside Avenue near Pearl Street.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Transportation.
