**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION  
FOR A NATIONAL HIGHWAY SAFETY ADMINISTRATION GRANT  
(2017 Distracted Driving—U Drive, U Text, U Pay)**

Councilman Whelan offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

**WHEREAS**, distracted driving is a dangerous epidemic on America's roadways and, in New Jersey, driver inattention remains the most significant cause of fatal and incapacitating crashes; and

**WHEREAS**, funds are available through the National Highway Safety Administration for a 2017 Distracted Driving Crackdown—U Drive, U Text, U Pay program to reimburse for special enforcement patrols targeting distracted drivers; and

**WHEREAS**, The Red Bank Police Department has requested that a grant application be submitted for the funds.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Red Bank that the Red Bank Police Department is authorized to apply for the 2017 Distracted Driving Crackdown grant and the Administrator is authorized to sign any and all document necessary to fulfill the purposes of this resolution.
