**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE BOROUGH OF RED BANK
TO ENTER INTO A COOPERATIVE PRICING AGREEMENT
(Education Service Center, Region 20—PACE Purchasing Cooperative)**

Councilwoman Horgan offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-11(5) authorizes contracting units to establish a Cooperative Pricing System and to enter into Cooperative Pricing Agreements for its administration; and

WHEREAS, the Education Service Center, Region 20 (PACE Purchasing Cooperative), hereinafter referred to as the "Lead Agency" has offered voluntary participation in a Cooperative Pricing System for the purchase of goods and services;

WHEREAS, on November 9, 2016 the governing body of the Borough of Red Bank, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey duly considered participation in a Cooperative Pricing System for the provision and performance of goods and services;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

- This RESOLUTION shall be known and may be cited as the Cooperative Pricing Resolution of the Borough of Red Bank
- Pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:11-11(5), the Administrator is hereby authorized to enter into a Cooperative Pricing Agreement with the Lead Agency.
- The Lead Agency shall be responsible for complying with the provisions of the *Local Public Contracts Law* (N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.) and all other provisions of the revised statutes of the State of New Jersey.
- This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
